

Tour #1 - South

McEvoy Ranch

McEvoy Ranch sits on 550 acres in the rolling hills west of Petaluma. Once a dairy farm, it has now been reincarnated as an organic olive tree orchard and olive oil mill. Other facilities on the ranch include a large 2 acre organic garden and retail store.

Bellwether Farms

Bellwether Farms sheep and cow dairy is located in the beautiful rolling hills of the Sonoma County coast. The farm is only a few miles from the ocean. Bellwether produces sheep's milk, yogurt, and world reknowned sheep and cow's milk cheeses.

Balletto Winery and Vineyards

John Balletto began farming vegetables in 1977, but has since converted to winegrapes and become one of the premier wineries in the Russian River Valley of Sonoma County. The 280 acre property is home to Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, Pinot Gris, and borders the Laguna de Santa Rosa, a vital wetland habitat.

Tour #2 - North

Beringer - Blass Wine Estates Cooperage

In 2001 Beringer Wine Estates began producing their own "in-house" wine barrels, with none being sold to outside wineries. Beringer Wine Estates is marker leader in California premium wine and consists of wineries such as Beringer, Chateau St. Jean, Meridian, Stags Leap, and St. Clement Vineyards.

Jordan Winery and Vineyards

Jordan Winery is located in Northern Sonoma County outside of Healdsburg, in Alexander Valley, home to one of the most concentrated wine-grape plantings in the United States. The valley soils are very fertile, which offers Jordan optimal growing conditions similar to that of Bordeaux and Rhone regions of France.

Santa Rosa Junior College Shone Farm

The Shone Farm totals 365 acres including winegrapes, timber, pasture for cattle and sheep, a sustainable Ag Unit, a market garden, a high density olive and apple planting, and livestock barns and corrals. The Warren G. Dutton Jr. Ag Pavilion compliments the farm with a riding arena, winery, and kitchen for cooking classes.
